John 4:9

1. Who do we think as “unclean”. What are you most likely to judge first when you see someone? (appearance, stereotype, friendly, scary, someone to avoid, etc.)

It is sometimes easy to avoid conversations and relationships. Even in a non-threatening atmosphere we tend to look toward children.

2. Classify who in your eyes is worthy/unworthy?

3. How do you find common ground and meet people where they are?

This verse lists three responsibilities for those who are Christ Followers.

Go:

- Define your mission field.
- Can you be a missionary without going overseas? Explain how that might look for you personally.

Tell:

- After you’ve gone, you’ve got to tell. How do we equip ourselves to do this?
- What elements of the gospel is it important to share?
- Talk about some things you should avoid when witnessing about Jesus to a friend. To a stranger? To a crowd?

Teach:

- Once someone accepts Christ what are some initial steps we can use to prompt people to learn more.
- List **PRACTICAL** steps that others in this Life Group can put into place beginning tomorrow.

Take time to pray for open doors and for specific people you are reaching out to right now in your world. List some first names, then pray as a group.
